

## **EMPLOYMENT AGENCIES**

- Employment agencies provide job contacts for positions which frequently begin as temp-to-hire (initial probation period of 60-90 days before permanent employment).
- This type of employment resource may require the applicant to take one or more skills inventory in order to determine whether the applicant meets minimum job skill requirements and pass a drug test which usually costs the applicant around \$20.
- Some agencies offer on-line skill development.
- Most employment agencies are for-profit businesses that offer services at no cost to the applicant. However, it is always best to ask ahead of time if a fee will be charged.
